



## Renovated AIS laboratory and holding facility:

Originally constructed in 1911 • Formerly a tractor garage

Now a state-of-the-art research center tackling the state's foremost AIS issues

### THE EQUIPMENT

- 200 gallons per minute of well water (capacity)
- 27 fish tanks and 50+ aquaria
- 4 plant growth chambers and 4 living streams
- 20 water temperature zones and 15 lighting zones

### THE BUILDING

- 10,398 square feet
- 13,500 feet of pipes
- 72,500 feet of electrical wire
- 4,400 engineering hours

### THE RESEARCH

Dedicated research rooms for invasive:

- Aquatic plants
- Invertebrates
- Fish
- Pathogens and microbes
